I'm also proud to have played a key role in securing new OEM business, contributing to our continued success.

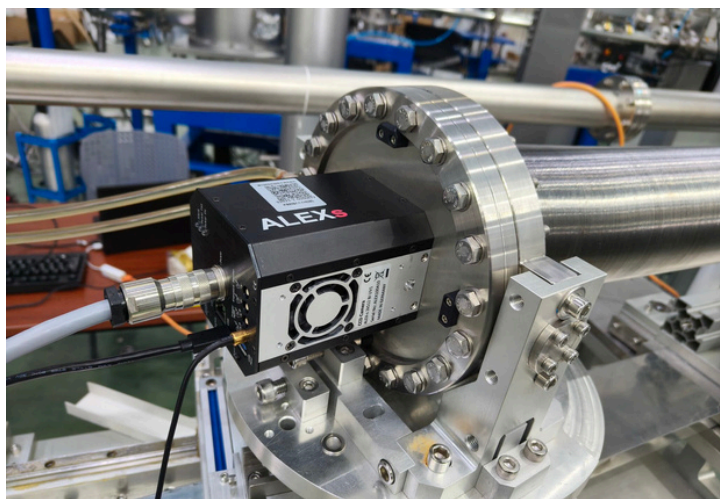
OUR CLEANROOM FACILITY IS NOW OPERATIONAL!
